Contact information is listed below, and any of us can and will accept an application from a homeowner. The application form is on the Aeries website aeriesonthebay.net. Our normal meeting dates are the 2nd and 4th Wednesdays of the Month. See the website for information, or contact one of the members.

Our process is for the ASC to make a recommendation to the Board, then the Board issues the final decision. The results of recent applications are shown below. In addition, we are almost finished with a complete survey of the neighborhood, checking for poorly maintained properties and out-of-compliance conditions (e.g., incorrect

paint colors). If you get a notice from the ASC, please take action to remedy the problem. The ASC believes that all of us in Aeries want this to be the best neighborhood we can be, both in livability and increased values. We are committed to that goal.

Parking

Did you know?

- 1) You must park your vehicle pointing in the direction of traffic on the side of the street.
- 2) You may not park within twenty (20) feet of a corner.
- 3) You may not park within fifteen (15) feet of a fire hydrant.
- 4) You may not park in front of mailboxes.
- 5) You may not have an inoperable or unlicensed vehicle in a visible location.
