

## TRAFFIC PROBLEMS

We have been asked to remind residents of parking regulations in the circles. Virginia Beach City Code 21-367 states that angle parking on cul-de-sacs is not permitted. Parallel parking to the curb is the only method permitted. Also, parking in the middle to the cul-de-sac is not permitted. The police do patrol our area and have issued parking tickets for these violations. Also, parking on the wrong side of the street and too close to a corner (20 feet) are violations

## REMINDERS

- Dogs are not allowed on the beach from Memorial Day until Labor Day from 10:00am to 6:00pm. Please do not take dogs to the beach during hot days, it is dangerous. When walking dogs they must be on a leash and you must "pick up the poop".
- No trash cans or recycle bins are to be kept in the front yard or driveway. Yard trash must be in clear bags. Special pickup must be requested for anything that will not fit in the black cans. Call 430-2450.
- Be a safe, slow driver in Aeries. Parking makes the street dangerous and children are out and about this time of year. Please drive with caution.

## TERMITES

It is termite swarming season, so be on the lookout. If not treated, termites can cause significant damage to the structure of your home. Homes should have a yearly termite inspection.
